Safety First

Working with 220V circuits is extremely dangerous and can cause severe injury or death. Always follow these safety measures:

- Wear insulated gloves and safety glasses; consider arc-rated clothing if accessing internal wiring .
- Use a multimeter rated for at least CAT III 300V, preferably CAT III 600V or higher .
- Ensure the circuit breaker is switched off before opening the distribution box or outlet cover .
- Treat all wires as live until verified with a multimeter .

Required Tools

- Digital or analog multimeter with AC voltage (VAC) capability.
- Insulated screwdriver to remove outlet or panel covers.
- PPE including gloves and safety glasses.

- Prepare the Multimeter: Set the dial to AC voltage (V~). If manual range, select a range higher than 220V, such as 600V
