

Cable tray expansion joint method

Cable tray expansion joints are installed to accommodate thermal expansion and contraction, ensuring system integrity and preventing stress on cables and supports.

Purpose of Expansion Joints

Cable trays expand and contract due to temperature fluctuations, which can cause bending, misalignment, or damage if not properly managed. Expansion joints absorb these movements, maintaining the structural and electrical integrity of the system while allowing natural thermal movement without straining the cables or tray supports .

Placement and Support

- Location: Expansion joints should be installed at regular intervals along the cable tray, particularly in areas with significant temperature variations, such as rooftops or outdoor installations .
- Support: Place cable tray supports within 2 feet of each side of the expansion joint splice plates. The tray should not be clamped too tightly to these supports, allowing free movement .
- Anchoring: Anchor the tray at the midpoint between expansion joints using hold-down clamps, while other supports use expansion guides to allow sliding movement .

- Determine the temperature range the tray will experience (e.g., winter to summer...
