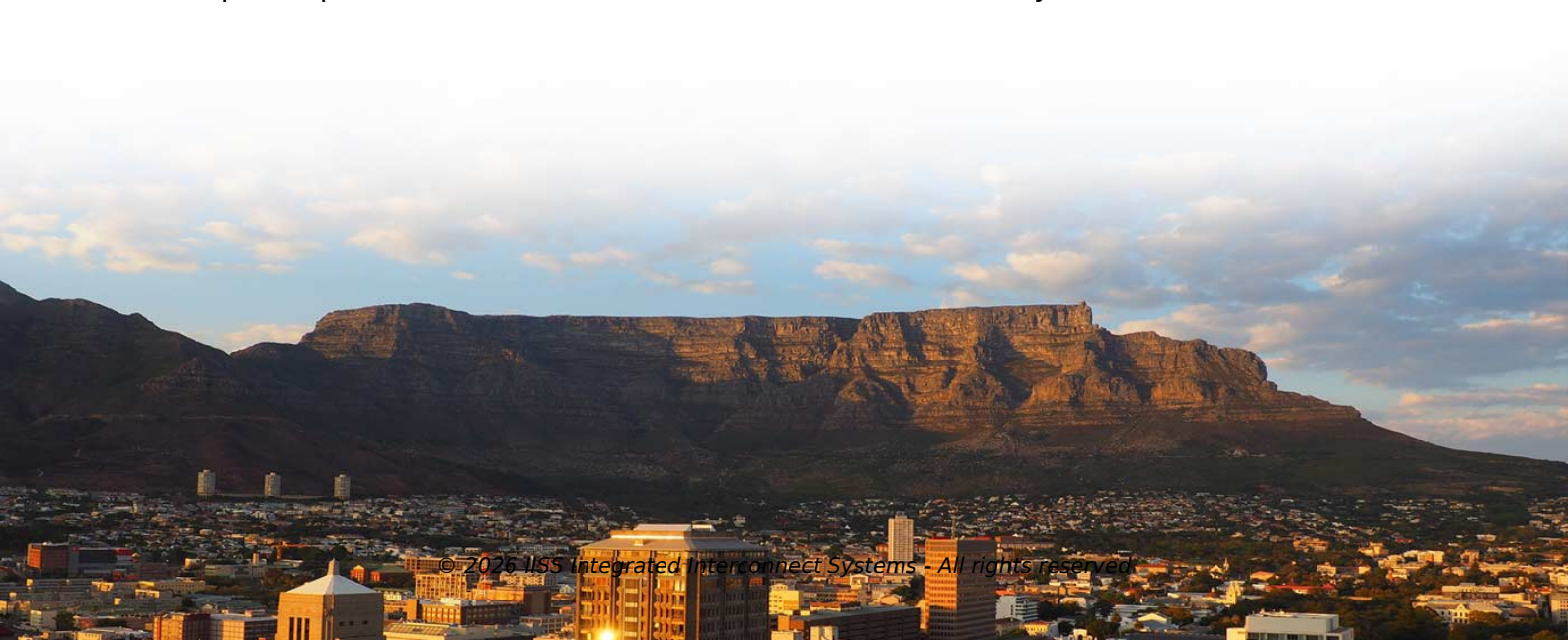


Cables need to be terminated when connected to the distribution box

Overview

If the wiring is still connected at the other end in the electric panel, it must be terminated in an electrical box. The National Electrical Code (NEC 300. 12) states that “Raceways, cable armors, and cable sheaths shall be continuous between cabinets . Metal raceways, cable armor, and other metal enclosures for conductors shall be metallically joined together into a continuous electric conductor and shall be so connected to all boxes, fittings, and cabinets as to provide effective electrical continuity.
