

Cold-joint fiber optic testing



Article Overview

Cold-joint fiber optic testing evaluates mechanical (non-fusion) connections to ensure signal continuity and acceptable optical loss, typically ranging from 0.2 to 0.5 dB.

Overview of Cold Joints

Cold joints, also known as mechanical joints, are used in fiber optic fast connectors where stripped fibers are inserted into a mechanical component and aligned using a fiber matching gel or liquid. Unlike fusion splicing, cold joints do not require heat or power, making them quick, portable, and suitable for field operations. However, they generally exhibit higher insertion loss (0.2–0.5 dB) and a slightly higher risk of malfunction compared to fusion splices.

Testing Methods

Testing cold joints involves verifying signal continuity, insertion loss, and optical alignment. The recommended procedures include:

- Tier 1 Testing (Mandatory):
 - Link attenuation using an Optical Loss Test Set (OLTS) or Light Source and Power Meter (LSPM) at the network's operating wavelength (e.g., 850 nm for multimode or 1310/1550 nm for single-mode)
 - Link length measurement via OLTS or cable sheath markings
 - Polarity verification using a Visual Fault Locator (VFL) or during attenuation testing
