

Configuration of All-Optical Port Switch

Article Overview

Optical port switches can be configured by installing the appropriate transceivers, assigning VLANs, and managing traffic through software or GUI interfaces, with options for local or remote control.

Hardware Setup

- **Install Optical Modules or SFPs:** Ensure the correct SFP or optical module is installed in the switch port. Multi-mode or single-mode fibers should match the transceiver type. For MEMS-based optical switches, micro-machined mirrors redirect light to selected ports, supporting up to 48 outputs per input fiber .
- **Clear Previous Configurations:** If replacing an existing optical module, clear prior configurations to avoid conflicts. For example, on Cisco NCS 1001, clear card parameters, OTS controller configurations, and optionally controller optics if replacing an EDFA module .

Port Configuration

- **Assign VLANs:** Configure VLANs for different traffic types. For example, management traffic can use VLAN 1, internet traffic VLAN 10, VOIP VLAN 20, and IPTV VLAN 30 .
- **Bind Bandwidth Profiles:** In GPON networks, bind T-Conts to DBA profiles to manage upstream bandwidth dynamically. Fixed bandwidth profiles reserve bandwidth for specific ONUs, while assured bandwidth profiles allocate remaining bandwidth to other ONUs .
- **Configure Switching Architecture:** Decide between blocking or non-blocking architectures. Non-blocking allows any input to connect to any output without restrictions, while blocking limits simultaneous connections
