Safety Distances

Maintaining adequate separation between cable trays and buried pipes is critical. Insufficient spacing can lead to:

- Electrical failures or fires due to heat radiation or vibration from nearby pipes.
- Chemical damage if pipes carry corrosive substances that could leak onto cables.
- Maintenance challenges, making inspections or repairs difficult and increasing downtime.
- Physical hazards, such as tripping or falling objects from trays. The exact distance depends on cable type, pipe contents, and operating conditions, but general engineering
