

Dangerous EU Optical Cable Factory

Article Overview

There is no publicly reported "dangerous" optical cable factory in the EU, but the sector faces regulatory, trade, and security challenges that can impact safety and reliability.

Regulatory Oversight

Optical cables in the EU are subject to strict safety and compliance standards. The Low Voltage Directive and harmonized standards such as EN 50406-1 for high bit rate telecommunication cables and EN 50288-1 for multi-element metallic cables ensure that cables meet electrical, mechanical, and fire safety requirements . These regulations apply to both cables sold with equipment and separately, covering voltage ranges from 50–1,000 V AC and 75–1,500 V DC, ensuring that manufacturing processes adhere to safety norms.

Trade and Industry Protection

The EU has actively protected its optical fibre industry from unfair competition. In response to dumping by Chinese exporters, the European Commission doubled anti-dumping duties on optical fibre cables from China, ranging from 39.4% to 88% . These measures aim to maintain a level playing field, protect EU jobs, and ensure that EU manufacturers can invest in advanced technologies like 5G without being undercut by artificially low-priced imports .
