Hot Aisle Anti-Static Cable

Hot aisle anti-static cables are designed for high-density data center environments where airflow management and electrostatic discharge (ESD) prevention are critical. These cables typically feature low-smoke, halogen-free, and anti-static jackets to reduce heat retention and prevent static buildup in hot aisle containment zones. They help maintain cooling efficiency and reduce the risk of equipment damage in tightly packed racks, making them ideal for short to medium intra-rack connections in high-density deployments .

Copper Cable

Copper cabling (Cat6A, Cat8, DAC) transmits electrical signals through metal conductors and is widely used for short-distance, high-speed connections such as top-of-rack (ToR) or server-to-switch links. Advantages include:

- Cost-effective for short runs and legacy systems .
- Low latency, especially with DAC (Direct Attach Copper) cables, which integrate transceivers and reduce signal conversion overhead
