

Distance between cable trays and air supply ducts



Article Overview

Maintain at least 100 mm horizontal and 300 mm vertical clearance between cable trays and air ducts to ensure safety, airflow, and maintenance access.

Recommended Clearances

- **Horizontal Distance:** Cable trays should be installed at a minimum of 100 mm from ventilation ducts. In projects where airflow is critical, this distance may be increased to 150 mm or more to prevent obstruction and allow proper air circulation .
- **Vertical Distance:** The vertical clearance between the top of the cable tray and the bottom of the air duct should generally be 300 mm. This spacing ensures adequate airflow, reduces overheating risk, and allows safe maintenance access .

Practical Considerations

- **Airflow and Heat Dissipation:** Power cables generate heat, and insufficient spacing can restrict airflow, leading to overheating and reduced cable lifespan .
- **Maintenance Access:** Adequate clearance allows technicians to inspect, repair, or replace cables without interfering with ductwork or other services .
- **Ceiling Coordination:** In commercial ceilings, cable trays often share space with ducts, pipes, sprinklers, and lighting. Early planning is essential to avoid clashes and ensure all services fit within the ceiling void .
- **Segregation of Cable Types:** Power, control, and data cables should be separated in different trays, with power trays typically mounted on top, followed by control and...
