- Distance and Signal Integrity: Fiber is preferred over copper for long runs (over 100 meters) to prevent signal attenuation and interference. Patch cords allow precise connections between devices and backbone cables .
- Optoelectronic Conversion: Cameras and NVRs often require fiber transceivers to convert electrical signals to optical signals. Patch cords connect these transceivers to the main fiber network
