He also twisted a few of the ground wires together and crimped them under a crimp sleeve, then ran a single wire underneath. Pigtailing is a wiring technique used in electrical installations where multiple wires are connected together using a short piece of wire, often referred to as a "pigtail. While it may look like extra work compared to simply looping the circuit. Wire-splicing and pigtailing within a loadcenter cabinet (panel enclosure) is expressly permitted by NEC 312. 8 (A), and is quite safe (provided the splices are made up properly, of course): (A) Splices, Taps, and Feed-Through Conductors.
