Many modern switches can have optical ports, either exclusively, in combination with Ethernet ports, or via SFP modules that support fiber connections.

Types of Switches with Optical Ports

Switches generally come in three configurations: those with purely Ethernet ports, those with purely optical ports, and hybrid switches that combine both types . Optical ports are designed to accommodate fiber optic modules, enabling high-speed data transmission over long distances, often exceeding 100 kilometers, compared to the shorter range of copper Ethernet cables . Common optical port speeds include 1.25G, 10G, 25G, 40G, and 100G, with some high-end models supporting even higher rates .

SFP and Combo Ports

Many switches feature SFP (Small Form-Factor Pluggable) ports, which are versatile slots that can accept either optical or copper modules . This allows a single port to function as an optical connection when a fiber SFP module is inserted, or as a copper Ethernet connection with a compatible module. Combo ports combine an RJ45 Ethernet interface and an SFP slot, but only one can be used at a time .
