

Drilling holes in fire cable trays



Article Overview

When drilling holes for fire-rated cable trays, ensure precise placement, compliance with fire safety regulations, and proper firestopping to maintain wall or floor integrity.

Planning and Layout

Before drilling, coordinate the cable tray route with the building structure to avoid unnecessary detours or interference with other services. Use the shortest and straightest path possible to reduce cable loss and simplify maintenance. Segregate power and signal cables in separate trays to minimize electromagnetic interference . Follow the contractor's layout or engineer's setting out for accurate hole placement .

Drilling Considerations

- **Material:** Holes may need to pass through concrete, blockwork, brick, or precast elements .
- **Precision:** Use diamond drilling or other precise methods to avoid structural damage and ensure clean penetrations .
- **Hole Size:** Openings should be slightly larger than the tray dimensions to allow for firestopping materials. For example, a 4" x 12" tray may require a 7" x 15" opening .

Firestopping Requirements

- **Sealing:** All gaps around the tray must be sealed with fire-rated materials such as firestop packs, mineral wool, firestop mastic, or intumescent caulk .
- **Backing Plates:** For large openings, install a fire-resistant backing plate before sea...
