Locating Your Distribution Box

Your home's distribution box—also called a breaker box or electrical panel—controls electricity to all circuits in your house. Common indoor locations include basements, utility rooms, garages, pantries, or hallways, often near where power lines enter the home. Outdoor panels are usually mounted on an exterior wall near the electric meter, allowing quick access for emergencies and utility inspections . Look for a rectangular metal box, typically gray, with a hinged door and warning labels .

Safety and Clearance

Electrical panels must follow National Electrical Code (NEC) requirements:

- Front clearance: minimum 36 inches
- Side clearance: at least 30 inches
- Height: main breaker handle no higher than 6'7", panel bottom at least 4 feet off the ground
- Prohibited locations: bathrooms, clothes closets, or areas with flammable materials
- Always keep the area around the panel clear and accessible for maintenance or e...
