Article Overview

Switch markings on factory power distribution boxes indicate circuit identification, electrical ratings, and safety information to ensure proper operation and compliance.

Purpose of Switch Markings

Factory power distribution boxes, including switchboards and motor control centers (MCCs), use markings to clearly identify circuits, incoming and outgoing feeders, and associated equipment. These markings help operators and electricians safely isolate circuits, prevent overloads, and reduce the risk of electric shock or arc flash hazards . Proper labeling also ensures compliance with safety standards and facilitates maintenance and troubleshooting .

Common Types of Markings

- **Electrical Identification Numbers:** Each switchboard or MCC is assigned a unique electrical identification number, which is used on drawings, schematics, and labels. For example, a main LV switchboard might be labeled as MAIN 440V L.V. SWITCHBOARD - (P410) REF: M1 .
- **Circuit Reference Numbers:** Each circuit fed from or incoming to the distribution box is given a reference number, often prefixed by the equipment ID. Junction boxes may use prefixes like CJB- (control junction box) or PJB- (power junction box), with sequential numbering for multiple boxes in the same circuit .
- **Electrical Ratings:** Labels indicate voltage, current, and frequency ratings to confirm compatibility with connected equipment and prevent overloads
