Fiber Optic Cables

Fiber optic cables transmit data as light signals through glass or plastic fibers. They are widely used in telecommunications, data centers, and FTTH (Fiber to the Home) networks due to their high bandwidth and low signal attenuation. Cables can be single-mode for long-distance transmission or multi-mode for shorter distances. Proper handling is critical: fibers must be stripped carefully, cleaned with isopropyl alcohol, and bent with a radius greater than 30 mm to avoid damage during installation ().

Fiber Optic Junction Boxes

A fiber optic junction box (or terminal/splice box) is a protective enclosure that organizes, stores, and secures fiber connections. These boxes serve as the interface between incoming cables and equipment tail fibers. They can be wall-mounted, ground-mounted, or rack-mounted, and are designed to maintain the minimum bend radius of fibers while providing easy access for splicing and patching ().
