They include protective layers such as buffer tubes, strength members, and outer jackets to resist mechanical stress, moisture, UV exposure, and other environmental factors, ensuring signal integrity over time . Direct connections are ideal for telecom backbones, long-haul networks, and inter-building links, where minimal insertion loss and high reliability are critical .
