Fiber Optic Connectors

Fiber optic connectors are mechanical devices that join optical fibers, allowing light signals to pass through with minimal loss or reflection. Unlike permanent splices, connectors enable easy connection and disconnection, which is essential for maintenance and network flexibility . Each connector contains a ferrule, usually made of ceramic or metal, that holds the fiber in precise alignment. Even microscopic misalignment can cause signal degradation, so precision is critical .

Common Connector Types

- SC (Subscriber Connector): Square-shaped with a push-pull mechanism, widely used in FTTH deployments and data centers. SC/APC variants are preferred for low return loss applications like GPON networks .
- LC (Lucent Connector): Miniaturized version of SC with a 1.25mm ferrule, ideal for high-density applications. It uses a latch mechanism similar to RJ45 plugs .
- ST (Straight Tip): Round connector with a bayonet-style twist lock, commonly used in legacy networks.
- FC (Ferrule Connector): Screw-on type, often used in high-vibration environments.
- MPO/MTP: Multi-fiber connectors for high-density data center applications . Conne...
