

Fiber optic module and pigtail connection

Article Overview

To connect a fiber optic module using a pigtail, fuse the bare end of the pigtail to the incoming fiber and plug the factory-terminated connector into the module or patch panel.

Understanding Fiber Optic Pigtails

A fiber optic pigtail is a short optical fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other. The connector end plugs directly into your fiber optic module, while the bare end is designed to be fusion or mechanically spliced to the incoming fiber cable in the field, ensuring low-loss, reliable connections .

Tools and Materials Needed

- Fiber pigtail of the correct type (single-mode or multi-mode)
- Fusion splicer or mechanical splicing kit
- Fiber stripper and cleaver
- Isopropyl alcohol wipes for cleaning
- Protective splice tray or enclosure
- Optional: visual fault locator or OTDR for testing

Step-by-Step Connection Process

- Prepare the Incoming Fiber Strip the protective jacket and buffer from the fiber using a fiber stripper. Clean the exposed fiber with isopropyl alcohol to remove dust and debris. Cleave the fiber end to create a smooth, flat surface for splicing .
- Prepare the Pigtail Ensure the pigtail's bare fiber is clean and properly cleaved. Th...
