

Grounding of the shielding layer of the optical cable splice box

The shielding layer of an optical cable in a splice box should be grounded to prevent electromagnetic interference and ensure safety, typically using single-end grounding for low-frequency signals and bonding to the enclosure or chassis.

Purpose of Shield Grounding

The metallic shielding layer in optical cables, such as OPGW or armored fiber, serves to block electromagnetic interference (EMI) and protect signal integrity. Grounding the shield ensures that induced voltages and currents are safely directed to earth, preventing noise from affecting the fibers and reducing the risk of electrical hazards to personnel during maintenance or splicing .

Single-End vs. Both-End Grounding

- **Single-End Grounding:** Recommended for low-frequency signals to avoid ground loops. The shield is connected to ground at one end only, usually at the source or the splice box enclosure, depending on the system configuration .
- **Both-End Grounding:** Used for high-frequency signals or long cable runs to improve EMI protection. Care must be taken to ensure that ground potentials are equal; otherwise, loop currents may form, causing interference .
