A structural offset in the sidewall creates strong, mid-span splices. Common cable tray fittings include cable tray elbows, tees, crosses, bends, risers, reducers, bolts and nuts, locks, expansion screws, supporting brackets, suspension rods, cross arms, bases, connecting plates, covers, fixings, cable cleats, and system dividers.
