

How does fiber optic cable communicate

Fiber optic cables transmit data using light pulses, offering high-speed, long-distance communication with minimal signal loss and immunity to electromagnetic interference.

How Fiber Optic Communication Works

Fiber optic communication transmits information by sending pulses of light through ultra-thin strands of glass or plastic called optical fibers. The light acts as a carrier wave that is modulated to encode data, representing binary information (0s and 1s) for digital communication. At the receiving end, a detector converts the light pulses back into electrical signals, reconstructing the original data. The principle enabling this transmission is total internal reflection, where light entering the fiber core is reflected entirely within the core due to the difference in refractive indices between the core and the surrounding cladding. This ensures that the light remains confined and travels long distances with minimal loss.

Structure of Fiber Optic Cables

A typical fiber optic cable consists of several layers:

- Core: The central region where light travels, made of high-purity glass or plastic.
- Cladding: Surrounds the core with a slightly lower refractive index to maintain total internal reflection.
- Buffer/Coating: Protective layer that shields the fiber from physical damage.
- Strength Members: Materials like Kevlar that provide mechanical support....
