

How to cascade switches with fiber optic cables

Cascading switches with fiber involves connecting the uplink ports of each switch using compatible fiber cables and SFP modules, while considering topology, redundancy, and cable type.

Choosing the Right Fiber and Modules

- **Fiber Type:** For short distances (under 500 meters), multimode fiber is typically sufficient; for longer distances, use single-mode fiber .
- **SFP/SFP+ Modules:** Ensure each switch has compatible SFP or SFP+ transceivers matching the fiber type and distance .
- **Connectors:** LC connectors are common for pre-terminated fiber cables, while SC connectors are also used depending on switch ports .
- **Pre-terminated Cables:** Using pre-terminated multi-strand fiber cables saves time and ensures high-quality connections .

Topology Options

- **Star Topology:** Each switch connects directly to a core switch. This is simple and reduces the risk of cascading failures but requires more fiber strands .
- **Cascading (Daisy Chain):** Switches are connected in series (core → switch A → switch B → switch C). This uses fewer fibers but a failure in one switch can disrupt downstream switches .
- **Tree or Bus Topology:** Useful for campus networks, combining star and cascade methods to balance performance and fiber usage
