

How to determine if an optical cable is broken

To determine if a fiber optic cable is broken, combine visual inspection with specialized testing tools like a Visual Fault Locator (VFL), Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR), and power meter measurements.

Visual Inspection

Start by examining the cable along its entire length for visible signs of damage, such as cuts, kinks, bends, frayed fibers, flattened jackets, or discoloration. Check the connectors at both ends for dirt, scratches, misalignment, or corrosion, as these can cause signal loss even if the fiber itself is intact . Using a fiber inspection microscope (200–400× magnification) can reveal scratches or pits on connector end-faces that may disrupt transmission .

Using a Visual Fault Locator (VFL)

A VFL injects visible red light into the fiber. If the light escapes at any point along the cable, it indicates a break, sharp bend, or severe fault. This method is quick and effective for field checks, especially for short distances or patch cords .

Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR)

An OTDR sends light pulses down the fiber and measures reflections to detect losses, breaks, or bends. It can pinpoint the exact location of a fault and quantify its severit...
