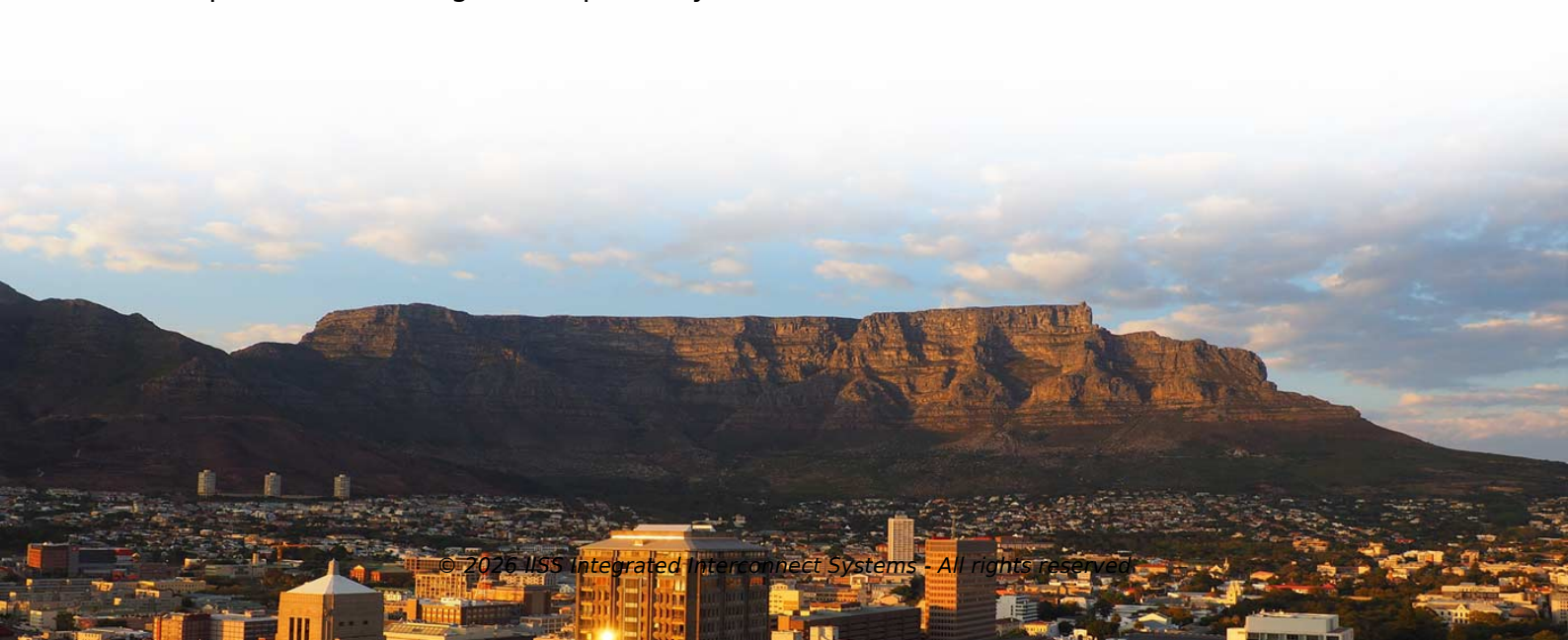


How to get indoor fiber optic cables into the terminal box

Overview

Secure the box with screws (ensure depth $\geq 40\text{mm}$). Run incoming fiber cable through the box's entry port. Connect ONT to socket with. The hardware selection process begins with choosing the appropriate fiber optic cable, which for residential FTTH installations is universally single-mode fiber. Single-mode cables use a very narrow core, typically 9 micrometers, supporting the long distances and high bandwidth required by internet. A fiber termination box is the standard instrument used in fiber optic networks to connect, secure, and protect optical fibers at the terminating point. It functions as a junction between the incoming fiber cable and the outgoing customer-side fiber cable, where one fiber can be spliced, patched. Installing a fiber wall socket (also called an FTTH outlet or optical termination point) is critical for maximizing your fiber internet speed and reliability. While ISPs often handle this, DIY installation can save time and money—if done correctly. This guide breaks down the process in easy steps so you know what to expect.
