- Pulling Grips and Rope Assemblies: Used to pull OPGW cables along towers while preventing fiber damage .
 - Tensioners and Anti-Twisting Counterweights: Maintain proper tension and prevent twisting during installation .
 - Self-Gripping Clamps and Swivels: Secure the cable at towers and allow controlled rotation to reduce mechanical stress .
