Understanding the Role of a Core Switch

A core switch is a high-capacity, high-performance Layer 3 switch that sits at the backbone of a network, aggregating data from distribution switches and ensuring ultra-low latency and high throughput across the network . It acts as the central hub for routing and switching, providing redundancy, scalability, and fault tolerance, which are critical for large enterprise networks, data centers, or high-bandwidth applications like VoIP, video conferencing, and AI workloads .

When a Core Switch May Not Be Needed

For small networks or SMBs with fewer than 50 connected devices, a dedicated core switch is generally unnecessary. In these cases, a robust router combined with managed access switches can handle traffic efficiently without creating bottlenecks . Networks with 50–150 devices can often use a collapsed core architecture, where a high-performance distribution switch performs both core and distribution functions, reducing hardware costs while maintaining adequate performance .

Factors Influencing the Decision

- **Network Size:** Larger networks with more than 150 devices typically benefit from a dedicated core switch to prevent backbone congestion
