While selecting the correct voltage rating and discharge current capacity is. Under NEC 2023 Article 230. 67, all services supplying dwelling units must have a Type 1 or Type 2 SPD installed. This requirement applies to: The code specifies that the SPD must be an integral part of the service equipment or located immediately adjacent to it. For contractors, this means surge. The 2023 National Electrical Code (NEC) significantly expanded and clarified requirements for surge-protective devices (SPDs).
