Optical Module

An optical module is a hot-pluggable transceiver that converts electrical signals into optical signals and vice versa, enabling high-bandwidth data communication over fiber optic cables . It typically contains a transmitter (laser or LED), a receiver (photodiode), and supporting electronics such as driver circuits, preamplifiers, and sometimes additional features like DSPs or FEC engines . Common form factors include SFP, SFP+, QSFP, and CFP, and modules can support various transmission rates from 1G to 100G or more . The module plugs into a device, such as a switch or router, and interfaces with the network through an optical port.

Optical Port

An optical port is the physical interface on a device where a fiber optic cable is connected. Ports can be duplex LC, simplex LC, or MPO/MTP, depending on the module and network requirements . The port itself does not perform signal conversion; it simply provides a connection point for the optical module to transmit and receive light signals. The port ensures proper alignment and protection of the fiber connector and may include features like spring-loaded latches for secure inser...
