They typically have all cables entering from one end, making them easier to handle during splicing and storing service loops. Dome closures provide robust environmental protection with advanced sealing systems such as O-rings and clamps to prevent water, dust, and insect ingress, ensuring long-term network reliability .

Inline Splice Closures

Inline closures have cable entries on both ends and are used when two identical cables need to be spliced together, such as in direct burial or repair applications. They save space and allow for efficient cable management along transmission routes. Inline closures are particularly useful for midspan access, where the cable jacket is stripped but most buffer tubes remain coiled inside, allowing selective splicing without fully opening the cable .
