

Protection radius of the secondary distribution box

Article Overview

The protection radius of a secondary distribution box is determined by the coverage of its low-voltage network and the protective devices installed, rather than a fixed physical distance.

Understanding Secondary Distribution Protection

A secondary distribution box (or substation) steps down medium voltage (typically 6.6–11 kV) to low voltage (up to 1 kV) for end-user consumption. Its protection is provided by fuses, circuit breakers, and network protectors that safeguard both the transformer and downstream circuits from overloads, short circuits, and reverse power flow . The effective "radius" of protection is therefore the area or number of customers that the secondary network can reliably serve without interruption.

Factors Affecting Protection Coverage

- Network Configuration:
 - Radial networks provide protection along a single path; a fault interrupts all downstream customers.
 - Spot networks or secondary selective service networks allow multiple transformers to feed the same secondary bus, increasing reliability and effectively expanding the protection coverage .
- Transformer and Feeder Capacity:
 - The size of the transformer and the number of feeders determine how much load...
