

Requirements for internal partitions of cable trays

Overview

Fill Limits: For power cables, the fill must not exceed 40% of the tray's cross-sectional area; for control cables, it's 50%. NEC Article 392 outlines the key rules for installing and maintaining industrial cable tray systems. These systems, made from metal or plastic, are open structures designed to support electrical conductors, ensuring proper organization and safety. 305(a)(3), or comparable standards promulgated by States.
