- **Residual Current Devices (RCCBs/RCDs/RCBOs):** Detect current imbalances between live and neutral conductors to reduce the risk of electric shock and fire caused by earth leakage .
- **Isolators:** Manually operated switches that allow safe disconnection of circuits for maintenance .
- **Bus Bars:** Metal strips that serve as central connection points for all circuits, including phase, neutral, and earth bars .
- **Enclosure:** Made from corrosion-resistant materials such as polycarbonate, ASA, or epoxy-coated steel, with appropriate IP ratings for indoor or outdoor use
