

Should outdoor fiber optic cables be single-mode or dual-mode

For outdoor fiber optic installations, single-mode fiber (OS2) is generally the preferred choice due to its superior long-distance performance and minimal signal loss.

Single-Mode vs Multimode for Outdoor Applications

Single-mode fiber (SMF) has a narrow core ($\sim 9 \mu\text{m}$) that allows only one light mode to propagate, which significantly reduces signal dispersion and enables data transmission over long distances, often exceeding 40 km for outdoor OS2-rated cables. This makes it ideal for outdoor backbones, campus networks, and telecom links where high bandwidth and signal integrity are critical. OS2 single-mode cables are specifically designed for outdoor use, featuring loose-tube construction that protects fibers from environmental stress, moisture, and temperature fluctuations. Multimode fiber (MMF), in contrast, has a larger core ($50\text{--}62.5 \mu\text{m}$) that supports multiple light modes. While it is cost-effective and suitable for short-distance applications such as data centers or intra-building connections, multimode fiber suffers from modal dispersion, limiting its effective range to a few hundred meters to a couple of kilometers outdoors. It is generally not recommended for long outdoor runs because signal quality degrades over distance.
