

Spacing between cable trays installed in vertical shafts

Overview

The 2026 NEC introduced an important update: cable trays must have at least 12 inches of clear vertical space above them to allow for installation and maintenance access. Proper installation can significantly reduce electromagnetic interference, prevent fire hazards, and improve overall efficiency. The NEC has a requirement for ladder-type cable trays. The rungs cannot be more than completely installed, without damage either to conductors or structural system use maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is bent the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when.
