

Standard requirements for the height of secondary distribution boxes

Article Overview

Secondary distribution boxes should generally be installed at a height of 1 to 1.8 meters from the floor, with adjustments for accessibility and environmental safety.

Recommended Installation Heights

- Residential Installations: The typical height for wall-mounted secondary distribution boxes is 1 to 1.8 meters from the floor, with 1.3 meters suggested for elderly or handicapped users to ensure easy access without bending or stretching excessively .
- Industrial Installations: In industrial settings, distribution boards with an IP54 protection rating are often mounted with a maximum height of 1.2 meters and a width of 1.5 meters to allow safe operation and maintenance .
- Outdoor Installations: Outdoor boxes should be installed at least 3 feet (approximately 0.9 meters) above ground to protect against water, dirt, and accidental impacts . Ground-mounted boxes should be slightly elevated (2-4 inches) to prevent moisture damage .

Clearance and Accessibility

- Adequate working space around the distribution box is essential. The NEC 110.26 and OSHA standards recommend a minimum clearance of 36 inches in depth, 30 inches in width, and 78 inches in height to allow safe operation and maintenance .
- Distribution boxes should be located in dry, ventilated, and easily accessible areas, away from water sources, excessive dust, or other environmental hazards
