

Switches restrict device access to the internal network

Overview

Switches are network devices that connect multiple devices together and forward traffic between them. In the context of securing your network, switches play a crucial role: Access control: Switches can be configured to restrict access to specific VLANs or ports. This allows you to separate devices on the same physical network into different groups based on their function, department, or level of access. My question is: how do I build ACLs (or VACLs) to explicitly restrict the traffic I. For example, IT can access all VLANs, Corporate can access IoT and CCTV, Guest cannot access any other VLAN. That means option 1 and 3 are preferred?

But what if I define ACLs on the destination?

All vlans have access to all other vlans and each device can ping other devices in other vlans.
