OM3 fiber is a laser-optimized multimode fiber designed for high-speed, longer-distance data transmission, while a pigtail is a fiber termination component with a connector on one end and bare fiber on the other, used for splicing.

OM3 Fiber Overview

OM3 is a multimode fiber (MMF) with a 50 μm core optimized for VCSEL laser sources, supporting high-speed Ethernet applications such as 10G up to 300 meters, 40G/100G up to 100 meters, and is typically aqua-colored for easy identification . It has an effective modal bandwidth (EMB) of 2000 MHz·km, making it suitable for data center intra-connections, LAN, and campus networks . OM3 is backward compatible with OM2 fiber but offers significantly higher bandwidth and longer reach.

Regular Pigtail Fiber Overview

A fiber pigtail is a short fiber segment with a connector on one end and bare fiber on the other, designed to be fusion-spliced to a fiber stub or distribution fiber inside a splice closure or patch panel . Pigtails are not a fiber type themselves; they can be made from single-mode or multimode fibers, including OM3. They are primarily used for terminating fibers in FTTH, ODN networks, or test setups, providing a connectorized interface for active equipment.
