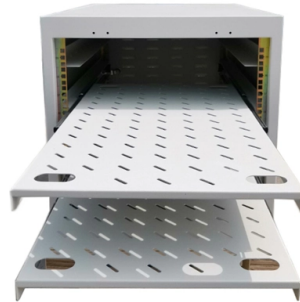


The function of an integrated optical fiber splice tray



Overview

The splice tray securely holds connector heatshrink covers in place, protecting them from vibration, handling, and accidental stress during re-entry. A fiber optic splice tray is a component of fiber optics management that is designed to securely and efficiently store and organize fiber fusion splice and slack. Splice trays are internal fiber management structures used to organize, protect, and separate optical fiber splices inside closures, terminal boxes, and distribution enclosures. Their primary function is mechanical rather than optical. Engineered for both indoor and outdoor splice. Once fibers are spliced, they need to be protected. For protection against the outside plant environment and damage, splices require placement in a protective enclosure, usually called a splice closure.
