Purpose and Benefits

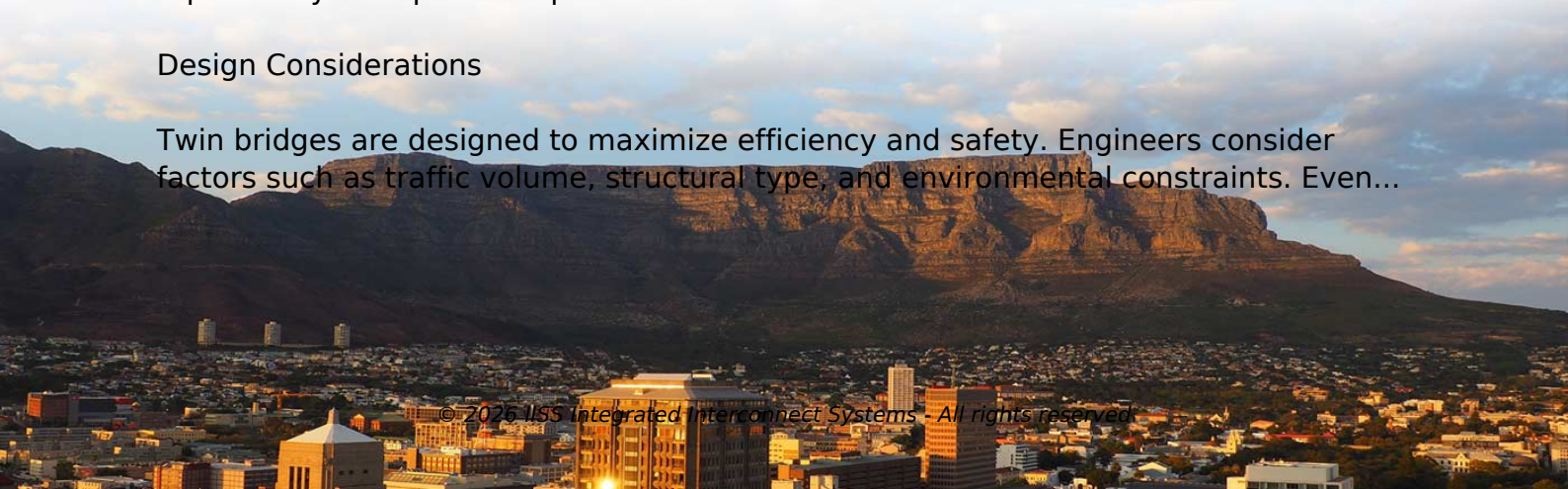
- **Traffic Capacity:** Twin bridges are often built to increase traffic flow by adding lanes without disrupting existing traffic .

- **Flexibility in Design:** Twin bridges may be identical or different in design, construction type, or number of lanes, depending on engineering requirements and available space .

Examples of Twin Bridges

- **Chesapeake Bay Bridge:** Twin suspension spans with differences in lane numbers and construction techniques .
- **Lake Pontchartrain Causeway, Louisiana:** The longest twin-span bridge in the world, with two parallel bridges built in 1956 and 1969 .
- **Delaware Memorial Bridge:** Identical twin spans built 18 years apart .
- **Carquinez Bridge, California:** Original cantilever span twinned in 1958, later replaced by a suspension span .
