 - Features include redundancy mechanisms like hot-swappable power supplies, modular cooling, and high-availability protocols such as VRRP or HSRP.
 - Ideal for large enterprise networks with heavy traffic and multiple distribution layers.
- **Collapsed Core Switches**
 - Combines core and distribution layer functions into a single switch.
 - Reduces hardware costs and simplifies network design while still providing high-speed backbone connectivity.
 - Often used in smaller networks or campuses where a full three-tier architecture is unnecessary.
 - Maintains Layer 3 routing capabilities but may offload complex policy routing to access or distribution layers to preserve backbone speed.
- **High-Capacity Layer 3 Core Switches**
 - Focused on routing between VLANs and subnets at wire speed.
 - Equipped with link aggregation, QoS, and VLAN support to manage large-scale traffic efficiently.
