

Vertical cable trays connecting to horizontal cable trays

Vertical cable trays connect to horizontal cable trays using elbows, bends, or specialized helix fittings to ensure smooth transitions and maintain cable support.

Methods of Connection

1. Elbows and Bends A common method is to use 90-degree or adjustable elbows to transition from a vertical riser to a horizontal tray. The horizontal tray typically starts with a downward bend so that cables can sweep smoothly from the vertical run onto the horizontal section. This method ensures that cables are not stressed or pinched during the transition and allows for proper cable routing in multi-story shafts or equipment rooms . 2. Helix Fittings Specialized helix fittings, such as those from Thomas & Betts, are designed to ease transitions between vertical and horizontal cable trays, particularly in confined areas or near walls. These fittings are available in left or right configurations and can be pre-assembled in aluminum, pre-galvanized steel, or stainless steel. Helix fittings save installation time and space while maintaining organized cable runs . 3. Custom or Modular Solutions In some cases, installers create custom families or modular sections in software like Revit to simulate vertical-to-horizontal connections. This approach can help plan the installation and ensure proper alignment before physical assembly .

Installation Considerations

- Support and Strain Relief: Ensure that vertical risers are properly supported to prevent sagging or cable stress. Ladder or channel trays may require additional brackets or vertical rails for stability .
- Cable Management: Maintain smooth bends to avoid sharp angles that could damage cables. Use cable ties or hooks as needed, but avoid over-tightening .
- Space Efficiency: Helix or pre-bent fittings are particularly useful in tight spaces, reducing the need for large clearance areas and simplifying installation .
- Material Selection: Choose tray materials (aluminum, steel, or stainless steel) based on environmental conditions, load requirements, and corrosion resistance .
