

What are the differences between jumper cables and pigtail cables

Fiber optic jumpers have connectors on both ends for active patching, while pigtails have a connector on only one end and are fusion-spliced to permanent fiber lines.

Fiber Optic Jumpers (Patch Cords)

Fiber optic jumpers, also called patch cords, are cables with connectors on both ends. They are designed for active connections between devices, such as optical transceivers, switches, routers, or between distribution frames and terminal boxes. Jumpers are typically used for reconfigurable front-side patching, allowing quick swaps or rerouting without touching the permanent fiber infrastructure. They have a thicker protective jacket to withstand handling and repeated plugging/unplugging, and come in various connector types like LC, SC, ST, or FC depending on the equipment interface .

Fiber Optic Pigtails

A pigtail is a short fiber cable with a pre-terminated connector on one end and a bare or fusion-ready fiber on the other end. The bare end is fusion-spliced to a permanent fiber line inside an optical distribution frame (ODF), terminal box, or closure. Pigtails are used to create clean, low-loss, serviceable interfaces at splicing and termination points. They are not meant for repeated plugging/unplugging; instead, they provide a permanent connection point for patching with jumpers
