

What are the material components of a fixed pigtail fiber

A fixed pigtail fiber consists of a glass core, cladding, protective buffer coating, outer jacket, and a factory-terminated connector.

Core and Cladding

The core is the central glass region that carries light signals, while the cladding surrounds the core and ensures total internal reflection, allowing efficient light propagation along the fiber . Single-mode fibers typically have a 9/125 μm core/cladding diameter, while multimode fibers use larger diameters such as 50/125 μm or 62.5/125 μm .

Buffer Coating

A buffer coating is a protective plastic layer applied directly over the cladding. In pigtails, this is usually a tight-buffered coating that shields the fiber from physical damage, moisture, and microbending, ensuring durability during handling and splicing .

Outer Jacket

The outer jacket provides additional mechanical protection and may be made from materials like PVC (Polyvinyl Chloride) or LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen), depending on fire safety requirements and installation environments . In pigtails, the jacket is...
