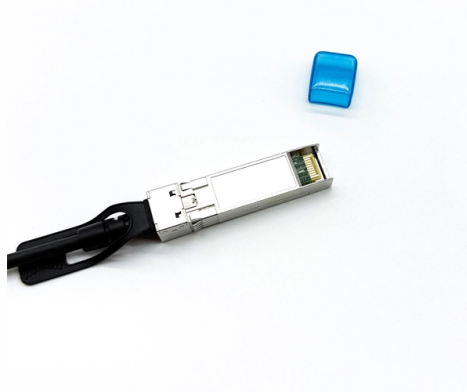


# What are the number of fiber cores in a single-mode optical fiber
