The circuit number of a distribution box identifies each individual electrical circuit, allowing for safe isolation, maintenance, and quick fault identification.

A distribution box (also called a panelboard, breaker panel, or consumer unit) divides incoming electrical power into multiple subsidiary circuits, each protected by a fuse or circuit breaker . The circuit number is a unique identifier assigned to each of these circuits, typically displayed on the breaker or fuse, which corresponds to a specific area, appliance, or system in a building . For example, L1 might indicate living room lights, K2 a kitchen socket, and AC3 a bedroom air conditioner .

- **Maintenance and Troubleshooting:** Clear numbering helps quickly locate and shut off power to a faulty circuit, reducing downtime and risk of electrical hazards .
- **Organization:** Numbering ensures that all circuits are systematically arranged, making it easier to manage complex electrical systems in residential, commercial, or industrial settings .
