10GBASE-LR is a 10-gigabit Ethernet optical standard that operates at 1310 nm over single-mode fiber (SMF), supporting link distances of up to 10 km. It is typically implemented using SFP+ transceivers and defined under IEEE 802. Through auto-negotiation, devices automatically select the highest supported speed, allowing. 10 Gigabit Ethernet (10GE, 10GbE, or 10 GigE) is a group of computer networking technologies for transmitting Ethernet frames at a rate of 10 gigabits per second. Unlike previous Ethernet standards, 10GbE defines only full-duplex. What is a 10G transceiver?

A 10G transceiver is a small pluggable module (commonly SFP+) or an integrated cable assembly that converts electrical signals on a switch/server port to optical or copper signals on the network medium. When used with fiber it's a fiber optic transceiver; when used with. With rare exceptions, a 100BASE-TX port (10/100) also supports 10BASE-T while a 1000BASE-T port (10/100/1000) also supports 10BASE-T and 100BASE-TX. I'll discuss Ethernet's electrical characteristics, and I'll describe how the Ethernet spec is divided into two major layers: the physical (PHY) and the medium access control (MAC).
