

What does civilian optical fiber cable include

Article Overview

Civilian optical fiber cables are primarily classified by mode, fiber count, construction, and jacket type, each suited for specific networking applications and environments.

1. Single-Mode vs Multi-Mode Fiber

- **Single-Mode Fiber (SMF):** Transmits a single light mode, offering very low attenuation and supporting long-distance transmission up to 100 km or more. It is ideal for telecommunications, long-haul networks, and high-speed backbone connections (OS1 for indoor, OS2 for outdoor and long distances) .
- **Multi-Mode Fiber (MMF):** Transmits multiple light modes, which can cause higher dispersion, making it suitable for shorter distances such as within buildings or campuses. Multi-mode fibers are further categorized into OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, and OM5, with OM4 and OM5 optimized for high-speed networks and wavelength division multiplexing (WDM) .

2. Fiber Count: Simplex vs Duplex

- **Simplex Fiber Cable:** Contains a single fiber strand, typically used for one-way signal transmission or with bidirectional (BiDi) transceivers .
- **Duplex Fiber Cable:** Includes two fiber strands, one for transmitting and one for receiving, making it standard for full-duplex communication and point-to-point links .

3. Cable Construction

- **Tight-Buffered Cables:** Fibers are coated with a protective layer, suitable for indoor use where flexibility and ease of installation are important. OS1 single-mode cables often use tight-buffered construction .
- **Loose-Tube Cables:** Fibers are laid in a spiral within semi-rigid tubes, allowing expansion and contraction without stressing the fibers. OS2 single-mode cables for outdoor and long-distance applications typically use loose-tube construction .

4. Jacket Types

- **PVC Jacket:** Common, cost-effective, and flexible, suitable for indoor applications but less resistant to fire and chemicals .
- **LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen):** Produces minimal smoke and no toxic gases wh...
