This design allows for high-quality, low-loss connections without the need for field-installed connectors, which are less reliable and more time-consuming to install .

- **Telecom Networks:** Pigtails link devices such as routers, switches, and telephones to fiber networks, ensuring reliable signal transmission .
- **FTTH and PON Systems:** SC/APC or LC/UPC pigtails are commonly used in fiber-to-the-home deployments to reduce back reflection and maintain signal quality .
