

What is the appropriate distance for fiber optic cable pulling

For indoor fiber optic cables, the maximum pulling distance typically ranges from 100 to 200 meters. The shorter distance accounts for the lower tensile strength and the need for gentle handling to avoid damage to the delicate fibers.
